Plumstead Bicycle Patrollers

The Plumstead bicycle patrollers were founded over 10 years ago, and their aim is to be the ears and eyes on the ground ensuring community safety, which is their number one priority.

The patrollers are made up of 7 members, who work from 06:00-18:00. They work closely with the reaction and TRF teams on the ground. All patrollers carry Hytera radios which allow them to communicate with the reaction teams, alerting them of activity in the area.

The patroller can be seen during the early hours of the morning, escorting employees to their jobs be it at residences, businesses, the old age homes, and the hospital in the area. They also stand down at the 2 schools ensuring children safety.



The **PNW Response Team** is comprised of local volunteers that are well experienced, trained and resourced by PNW. The team uses their own time and fuel to respond to various emergency situations in our area.

Our team responds to everything from active crime complaints such as house breakings in progress to motor vehicle and motor bike accidents and various medical and trauma emergencies.

The team conducts regular training to ensure that our responders assist according to local standards and norms.



Response Team Activation:

09 April 2022

While on patrol in the late evening, PNW Patrollers and response team members were alerted to an assault that had taken place on Gabriel Road near the circle.

Arriving on the scene, PNW members along with local Law Enforcement officers found one male patient who had suffered from multiple traumatic injuries.

The patient was stabilized while CVIC organized Emergency Medical Services. A SA Paramedic ambulance arrived on scene and transported the patient to hospital in a stable condition.

Re-beautifying the Gabriel Road Precinct in Plumstead, Cape Town

Gabriel Road Area Project Association (also known by residents as GRAPA) is a registered NPO with registration number 2020/891518/08 formed in August 2020. A group of like-minded business owners and residents with properties on the top end of Gabriel Road and surrounds formed the Residents Association to work alongside the City of Cape Town, Plumstead Neighbourhood Watch and various security companies and organisations serving the area to improve the overall security and to beautify its open spaces. The NPO currently has a membership representing 130 households. The Association oversees a number of community clean-ups and projects to beautify the area. This includes painting previously grubby looking walls that back onto common areas, the establishment of pavement gardens, planting over 50 trees, litter cleaning and field greening. One of the larger projects is the leasing of open land (Bardia Road behind the Shell Garage) from the City of Cape Town to establish a Community Food Garden Project in partnership with the City of Cape Town. The plan is to fence off the land and establish a fruit and vegetable garden that will benefit the community. We also envision beautifying the space to include benches for residents to enjoy the view and to feed the birds in a safe environment. Opportunities will be created for residents to work at the Community Food Garden in exchange for remuneration and fresh produce boxes. You are invited to join the Gabriel Road Area Project Association as a member if you live in the area, volunteer to contribute towards the Food Garden Project or work with the planning team.
