We thank all the participants, CVIC and their controllers, and BKM for their part in this successful operation.



Motorbike Accident - De Waal Road

PNW and Compass Towing responded to reports of a motorbike accident that had occurred on De Waal Road, just before Main Road. Initial reports indicated that the rider of the motorbike sustained moderate injuries.

PNW medical personal provided initial care to the patient until Fire and Rescue as well as ER24 arrived to transport the patient to hospital for more definitive care and treatment. The patient expressed her thanks and appreciation to the first responders for their care.

The accident occurred during peak hour traffic. PNW first responders conducted scene safety and assisted with the safe direction of traffic. We thank all role players involved.

<u>Response Team Activation – Serious Motorbike Accident:</u>

PNW's newly formed response team was activated for reports of a serious motorbike accident that had occurred on Gabriel Road. PNW first responders arrived on scene to an unconscious patient surrounded by bystanders attempting to provide First Aid.

PNW medical personal took over the care until Fire and Rescue and METRO EMS arrived to transport the patient to hospital for further care. PNW first responders provided scene safety and traffic control until the scene was cleared and traffic was free – flowing,

We urge members of the public to drive carefully and remain vigilant of bikers. We also urge members of the public to not move victims of accidents unless an extreme danger exists.
